### EASEMENT AGREEMENT

2. First Party, their heirs, successors and assigns agree that at such time said building is removed from the premises that any replacement building shall be placed within the boundaries of the real estate owned by First Party. At such time the easement granted herein shall end and be of no further force and effect.
3. First Party, their heirs, successors and assigns shall take no actions with regard to said building which will in any way increase or expand the currently existing encroachment. This easement agreement shall be binding upon First Party, their heirs, successors and assigns.

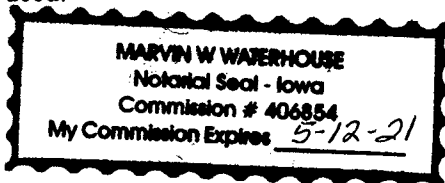

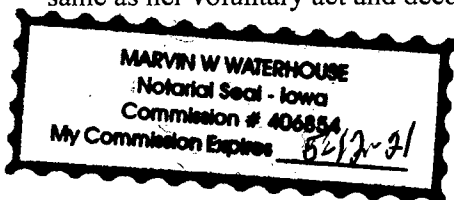
